**Orfalea pledges  
\$500K to UCSB**

Kinko's founder Paul Orfalea and his charitable foundation will give \$500,000 per year to the University of California, Santa Barbara for a new master's degree program in international studies, UCSB announced May 3.

Orfalea is a visiting professor in the Global and International Studies program, where he teaches a course in international business.

UCSB will call the new graduate program the Orfalea Center for Global and International Studies.

Orfalea opened the first Kinko's in 1970, in the UCSB college town of Isla Vista. Kinko's is now owned by FedEx. Orfalea is a Montecito resident and a co-founder of West Coast Asset Management in Ventura.
