**WCAM announces sale
of Register.com shares**

West Coast Asset

Management, co-founded by Kinko's Founder **Paul Orfalea**, announced the sale of 1.16 million shares of **Register.com Inc.** (Nasdaq: RCOM) at a significant premium.

"We began purchasing shares of Register.com in November 2005, based on the company's tangible asset value and its ability to generate free cash flow," stated WCAM President **Lance Helfert**.

"The current price no longer reflects what we would consider a 'safety cushion', and we believe competitive pressures may be a challenge for Register.com in the future."

Recent bids for Register.com represent WCAM's third portfolio-company acquisition offer in 2005 — its sixth since inception in 2001.

Founded in 2000 by Helfert and Orfalea, West Coast Asset Management manages assets in excess of \$350 million with clients in more than 10 states.

WCAM provides exclusive equity and fixed-income management for high-net worth individuals, institutions and charitable foundations.
